GOPAC Releases Report on Allegations of Corruption Against Trinidad and Tobago's Former Senator Mary Kay King

Ottawa – The Global Organization of Parliamentarians Against Corruption (GOPAC) released a report today on its investigation into allegations of corruption against former Senator Mary Kay King. The report affirms GOPAC's support of its long-time member and Secretary of the Board.

The report is an account of GOPAC CEO's investigation into corruption allegations against Ms. King by the government of Trinidad and Tobago. The investigation took place in Trinidad November 29 to December 1, 2011.

“From the perspective of GOPAC, Ms. King was acting in what she believed to be the best interest of the Government of Trinidad and Tobago,” said GOPAC founder and CEO John Williams. “GOPAC fully supports Ms. King and will be retaining her as a Member of the Executive and the Secretary of our Board of Directors.”

“The fight against corruption is an ongoing battle in Trinidad and all around the world, and we are glad Ms. King will continue to be an advocate against corruption in Trinidad and Tobago,” concluded Mr. Williams.
